



Transplant Center Evaluation and Review Process 2014

Scientific Registry of Transplant Recipients (SRTR)

Semiannually, Center-Specific Reports are published by the Scientific Registry of Transplant Recipients (SRTR), which is administered by the Minneapolis Medical Research Foundation. These reports include multi-year, multi-variate analysis of national comparative survival data. They also include era results for survival rates at 1 month, 1 year, and 3 years adjusted for many variables.

Network 11 Kidney Transplant Center Review Process

To monitor kidney transplant outcomes, Network 11's Medical Review Committee (MRC) reviews the SRTR Reports. The MRC uses the center-specific profiles to review transplant centers with patient or graft survival rates that are significantly lower than expected. Reviews may include off-site review, on-site review, and further data analysis methods.

Medical Review Criteria Update for 2014

Transplant centers will be selected for review based on one or more of the following criteria.

- **Scientific Registry of Transplant Recipients results:** Patient or Graft Survival lower and statistically different from expected results on the SRTR center specific report for kidney transplants.
- **Referral:** Referral from a State Survey Agency, patient or facility referral, or other reason as determined by the Medical Review Committee.
