#### Post-Dialysis Fatigue




The NIDDK is hosting a two-day workshop on Post-Dialysis Fatigue. The workshop will include current & former dialysis patients, care partners, healthcare providers, researchers, and government agencies. The workshop will feature discussions about what we know and don't know about post-dialysis fatigue. You will hear from people on dialysis about how fatigue makes them feel, from doctors on the state of the practice, and from researchers on how we measure fatigue and what causes fatigue. There will also be time for discussions where audience members are encouraged to share how they feel after dialysis treatment and how it affects their livelihood.
